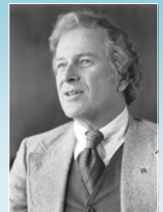

Call for Nominations



In 1988, the National Credit Union Foundation created the Herb Wegner Memorial Awards in honor of late CUNA CEO Herb Wegner, whose innovative ideas and deeds revolutionized the ways that credit unions serve their communities. The awards carry on Wegner's spirit of "innovative, creative, risk-taking" leadership.



Call for Nominations

Nominations can come from individuals and/or organizations. Current members of the NCUF board and/or staff are not eligible for nomination.

Complete the **Call for Nominations Form** located on the back of this brochure and submit along with **at least five, but no more than ten letters of recommendation** in support of the nomination.

Letters must cite at least three descriptive reasons for the nomination.

REMINDER: Nomination form and letters must be received **via email** no later than **Friday, June 17, 2011**.

Selection

Selection will be made by the NCUF Awards and Recognition Committee comprised of representatives from NCUF and other credit union related organizations. Scoring will be based on information provided on the nomination form and in the letters of recommendation. Award recipients will be notified no later than Friday, July 29, 2011.

Awards Presentation

Awards will be presented at the 24th Annual Herb Wegner Memorial Awards Dinner on Monday, March 19, 2012, in Washington, D.C. in conjunction with the Credit Union National Association's Governmental Affairs Conference (GAC).

Each recipient will receive two complimentary tickets to the awards dinner.

Lifetime Achievement

To honor an individual who has dedicated their life to promoting the credit union philosophy, created innovative concepts and provided leadership that has had a significant and lasting impact on the national and/or international credit union. Recognition for individual posthumously or for retired individuals must occur within five years of death or retirement. Criteria:

- Accomplishment(s) must relate to the Foundation's mission to promote and improve consumer financial independence through credit unions;
- Demonstrated leadership and guidance in maintaining the credit union philosophy of people helping people;
- Demonstrated visionary leadership, personal commitment and innovation beyond professional competence and requirements of the position employed to serve; Demonstrated identifiable and lasting changes to improve/promote credit unions;
- Recognized nationally and/or internationally for work in/or relating to credit unions; and,
- Recognized for mentoring and inspiring others in advancement of the credit union system.

Individual Achievement

Nomination must cite a specific subject of achievement such as financial literacy, service to the unserved or underserved community, alternatives to predatory lending, developing new products, etc. This award is intended to honor an unsung hero for their innovative concepts and/or accomplishments that are ongoing and current contributions to the credit union community for their work within the past ten years.

Accomplishments must have had a significant impact or a potential impact on the national and/or international credit union movement with measured results. Criteria:

- Accomplishment(s) must relate to the Foundation's mission to promote and improve consumer financial independence through credit unions;
- Measurements that quantify how the accomplishment(s) have impacted the national and/or international credit union movement;
- Demonstrated leadership and guidance in maintaining the credit union philosophy of people helping people; and,
- Demonstrated personal commitment and innovation beyond professional competence and requirements of the position employed to serve.

Outstanding Organization or Program

To honor an organization, program or business for their innovative concepts and/or product/services that have had a significant impact on the national and/or international credit union movement with measured results. Criteria:

- Accomplishment(s) must relate to the Foundation's mission to promote and improve consumer financial independence through credit unions;
- Measurements that quantify how the accomplishments have impacted the national and/or international credit union movement;
- Relates to core credit union values of mutual self-help, cooperation, economic empowerment and volunteerism; and,
- Supports community partnerships/collaboration outside the credit union system.
